## From walking in or through to walking with the city (again)

When thinking about walking, we immediately envision a human activity, something people do somewhere, with the environment in which the walking is taking place being a mere passive background of the action. This anthropocentric understanding of what walking entails is typically Western. More-than-human approaches help us deconstruct such dualistic ideologies. They point to the ethical and political relevance of moving-with (the environment) to feel/think the intensities of the entanglements of human and world. Moving-with forces people to rely on their affective experiences. Becoming accountable to the more-than-human involves taking account of the multiple erasures of other knowledges and methods. Moving-with, then, becomes a movement of thought not only with "others," but a process of engaging with erased or disavowed histories. As such, it is a moving re-engagement with the ways that the planet and its constituent parts have been understood, protected, feared, and treasured. In this talk, then, I want to reflect on what walking-with entails in an urban context.

## O autoru

Noel B. Salazar profesor je socijalne i kulturne antropologije na Katoličkom sveučilištu Leuven u Belgiji. Područja njegova znanstvena interesa, između ostalog, uključuju antropologiju (ne)mobilnosti, baštinu i turizam te imaginarije Drugoga. Urednik je Berghahnove serije knjiga *Worlds in Motion* te zbornikā *Pacing Mobilities* (2020), *Methodologies of Mobility* (2017), *Mega-event Mobilities* (2016), *Regimes of Mobility* (2014) i *Tourism Imaginaries* (2014). Salazar je i autor dviju knjiga *Momentuous Mobilities* (2018) i *Envisioning Eden* (2010) te brojnih znanstvenih radova. Od 2013. do 2014. godine bio je predsjednik Europskog udruženja socijalnih antropologa (EASA) te je osnivač AnthroMob-a, EASA-ine mreže za antropologiju mobilnosti.
